Scholarship Criteria

Four-year scholarships for students graduating from Waterloo East High School. Priority will be given to individuals in the top 10 percent of their class and/or with an ACT composite score of 25 or above. Students must also demonstrate financial need. In order to continue receiving the scholarship the subsequent three years in college, the individual must carry at least 15 credit hours each semester the previous year and have at least a 2.5 grade point average each semester of the previous year.
