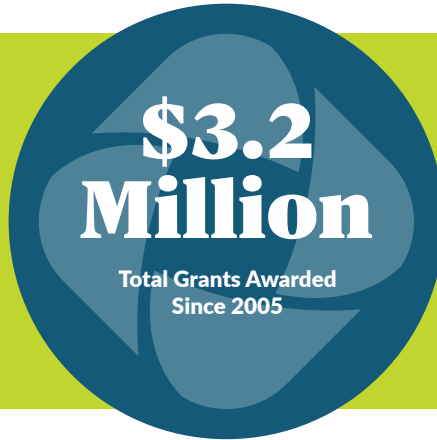




# Here for Good.
