

# Hynes Spur Trail Funds



## About the Hynes Spur Trail

Named after Dr. Richard Hynes (retired dentist) and his wife Vera, the Hynes Spur Trail is an approximately two-mile paved stretch of nature trail in Forest City, Iowa. The Trail stretches between J Street (Pammel Park) and County Road B14 (Airport Road). It flows through the campground, along the Winnebago River and through the Bear Creek Golf Course in Pammel Park. The Trail connects to nine miles of Hanson Trail that connects to Pilot Knob State Park. Its gentle terrain, scenic waterways, and forested areas provide an excellent environment for recreational cycling, running, skating, and walking.

## About the Funds

The **Hynes Spur Trail Endowment Fund** is a permanent endowment fund, meaning the fund is invested and grows over time, providing a long-term, stable source of income to preserve the future of the Hynes Spur Trail. Gifts to permanent endowment funds are eligible to receive a 25% state tax credit through the Endow Iowa program, in addition to the federal deductions for charitable gifts.
