About the Inwood Ballroom

The Inwood Ballroom in Spillville, Iowa, is one of the Midwest's oldest continuously operating dance halls, first opening in 1920 as a community gathering space along the Turkey River. Originally built as an open-air "bowery" to help raise funds for a soldiers' memorial, it has since become a historic landmark known for its distinctive ten-sided hardwood dance floor, vaulted ceilings, and stone fireplaces. For more than a century, it has served as a vibrant gathering place for dances, weddings, and community celebrations, carrying forward a strong tradition of music and connection in rural Iowa. Today, the Inwood Ballroom continues to operate through the stewardship of the Civic Improvement Association of Spillville, Iowa, which established dedicated funds to support its preservation and ongoing use. These efforts ensure this treasured space remains a welcoming hub for community life for generations to come.

About the Funds

The **Inwood Ballroom Endowment Fund** is a permanent endowment fund, meaning the fund is invested and grows over time, providing a long-term, stable source of income to carry out the mission of the organization now, and forever. Gifts to endowment funds are eligible to receive a 25% state tax credit through the Endow Iowa program, cfneia.org/endowiowa. The **Inwood Ballroom Quasi Endowment Fund** is also invested but allows for increased flexibility to access funds when needed.
